Sunday Readings

Gen. 18:1-10 "Lord do not pass your servant by."

Psalm THE JUST WILL LIVE IN THE PRESENCE OF THE LORD

Colossians 1:24-28 "A mystery hidden for centuries has now been revealed to God's saints"

Luke 10:32-42 "Martha has welcomed Jesus into her house, Mary has chosen the better part"

The story of Jesus in the home of Martha and Mary complements the story of the Good Samaritan, which immediately precedes it in Luke's Gospel. The Samaritan is an example of how a disciple should see and act. Mary is an example of how a disciple should listen. Jesus is teaching that being a disciple is a radical way of living. A Samaritan would not be a model for neighbourliness, so a woman would not sit with the men around the feet of a teacher. Chapter 10 of Luke's gospel begins with the command of love of God (Mary) and love of neighbour (the Samaritan). The Kingdom of God requires times for seeing and doing and times for listening and learning at the feet of the teacher.
