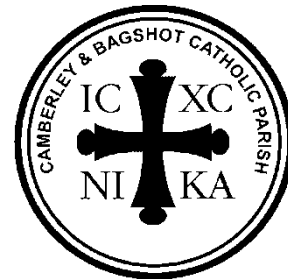

On Remembrance Sunday we remember all those who gave their lives for their country, because the Church recognised the right of legitimate self-defence. However, we must also remember all that have suffered and died through war and armed conflict and promote the cause of justice and peace. The Catholic Catechism teaches "Respect for human life requires peace. Peace is not merely the absence of war, and it is not limited to maintaining a balance of powers between adversaries. Peace cannot be attained on earth without safeguarding the goods of persons, free communication among men, respect for the dignity of persons and peoples, and the assiduous practice of fraternity. Earthly peace is the image and fruit of the peace of Christ, the messianic "Prince of Peace." This prayer is attributed to a Confederate soldier towards the end of the American Civil War.

I asked God for strength, that I might achieve;
I was made weak, that I might learn humbly to obey.
I asked for health, that I might do greater things;
I was given infirmity, that I might do better things.
I asked for riches, that I might be happy;
I was given poverty, that I might be wise.
I asked for power, that I might have the praise of men;
I was given weakness, that I might feel the need of God.
I asked for all things, that I might enjoy life;
I was given life, that I might enjoy all things.
I got nothing that I asked for, but everything I hoped for.
Almost despite myself, my unspoken prayers were answered.
I am among all men most richly blessed.
