Please pray for the repose of the soul of **Fr David Weston RIP**, a priest of our diocese, who died this week. Please also pray for **Bishop Francis Walmsley RIP** who died on the 26th December. He was the Catholic bishop of the armed forces from 1979-2002. His Requiem Mass will take place at 11:30am on Tuesday 23 January 2018 at the Cathedral Church of St Michael and St George, Queens Avenue, Aldershot.

In the gospel reading, John the Baptist introduces two of his own disciples to Jesus, Andrew being the key player. John points Jesus out to them by exclaiming: “Look, there is the Lamb of God!” A conversation then develops between Andrew and Jesus, a conversation sprinkled with seeking words like, “What do you want?” “Where do you live?” “Come and see,” and “Come with me,” all of them filled with the relational words of friendship. These words are also a personal invitation for us to live closely with Jesus. At the heart of our religious faith is the friendship between us and God in Jesus Christ. At the end of His life during the Last Supper, Jesus gets down on His knees, washes feet, stands up and looking each one in the eye says: “I no longer call you slaves ... I call you friends.”

Jesus had no army. He neither needed one nor wanted one. He had the only one power with which to conquer the human spirit, the power of a loving friendship. That is the only thing that can invade and conquer the human heart. Brute force always fails; love always wins.
