

From 'Divine Renovation' by Fr James Mallon

How do we make disciples? If a disciple is one who learns, who yearns to grow, who hungers for knowledge, how does this happen? We know that just because someone 'believes' in Jesus or 'goes to church' does not necessarily mean they have this hunger. Something must happen to awaken this hunger, that something is evangelisation. To 'evangelise' means to announce the Good News, but what is this Good News? We can speak of the message of 'God with us', of God's mercy, of the defeat of death in the Resurrection. Ultimately, however, it is possible to simplify the message into one word — Jesus. To be evangelised is not only to hear these wonderful truths, to know about them, but to come to know him, to not just believe in him but to love him and be in love with him.
