Mark 3:20-35 "The smallest of seeds
grows into the biggest shrub of them all"

The parables in Marks gospel are images of the Kingdom of God. God's work is compared to a farmer planting seed. Once the seed is ripe, it is for the farmer to bring in the harvest. Our task is to bring in the harvest which has been planted in the hearts of people. In the second parable the Kingdom is compared to a mustard seed. The tiniest of seeds grows into a shrub in which birds can build their nests. We need trust in the power of the Kingdom so that we can plant the seed with confidence and conviction.
