**Sunday Readings**

**Jeremiah 38:4-6,8-10** "I have born me a man of dissension for all the land."

**Psalm LORD COME TO MY AID."**

**Hebrews 12:1-4** "We shall keep on running steadily in the race we have started"

**Luke 12:49-53** "I am not here to bring peace but rather division."

Jesus tells the disciples that he has come to set the earth on fire. The fire Jesus speaks of here is the distress caused by the coming judgment. It is also the fire of the Spirit that Luke, in the Acts of the Apostles, will describe descending on the disciples on Pentecost. That fire will strengthen them to go out to the whole world to preach the good news of Jesus' Resurrection. Jesus will be the first to experience the distress in his death on the cross. His followers will not be spared that distress. Jesus tells the crowd not to think he has come to bring peace; he has come to bring division. Peace is the ultimate end of the Kingdom of God, but peace has a price.
