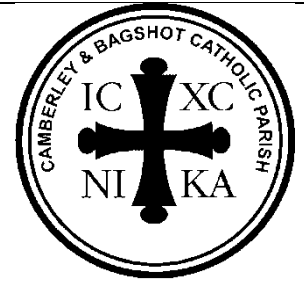

C&B Parish Charities Committee (PCC)

Of the 52 weekends of the year on 18 of them we must take mandatory diocesan retiring collections. All bids should be made to the office by **31 October**. The PCC will then hold a special meeting at the beginning of December and make the allocations. Unsuccessful bids may be considered for the following year.
