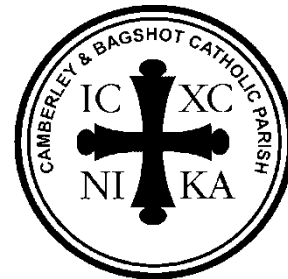

Pope Francis has dedicated this Sunday the 19<sup>th</sup> November, as the first **'World Day of the Poor'**. In his message Pope Francis wrote: *"We know how hard it is for our contemporary world to see poverty clearly for what it is. Yet in myriad ways poverty challenges us daily, in faces marked by suffering, marginalization, oppression, violence, torture and imprisonment, war, deprivation of freedom and dignity, ignorance and illiteracy, medical emergencies and shortage of work, trafficking and slavery, exile, extreme poverty and forced migration. "I invite the whole Church, and men and women of good will everywhere, to turn their gaze on this day to all those who stretch out their hands and plead for our help and solidarity. They are our brothers and sisters, created and loved by the one Heavenly Father. This Day is meant, above all, to encourage believers to react against a culture of discard and waste, and to embrace the culture of encounter."*

During Holy Mass we will be invited to consider how we can create moments of encounter and friendship. You'll have the chance to complete a post card expressing how you might be interested to explore ways to walk with those experiencing poverty. Please complete the card when you are invited to do so and return it.
