Exodus 17:3-7 God tells Moses to bring forth water from the rock.

Psalm: O THAT TODAY YOU WILL LISTEN TO HIS VOICE HARDEN NOT YOUR HEARTS

Romans 5:1-2,5-8 Christ died for us while we were still sinners.

John 4:5-42 The water that I shall give will turn into a spring of eternal life

On this Sunday and the next two Sundays, we break from reading the Gospel of Matthew to read from John's Gospel. In today's Gospel, the dialogue between Jesus and a woman from Samaria is among the most lengthy and most theological found in Scripture. The significance of the encounter between Jesus and the Samaritan woman has many levels. The first is personal: The woman is herself converted to belief in Jesus as Messiah because he knows her sin but speaks with her just the same. The second is social: Having come to know Jesus as the Messiah, the Samaritan woman becomes an evangelist to her own people.
