### Sunday Readings

**Isaiah 49:3,5-6** God's servant, Israel, will be made a light to the nations.

**Psalms** HERE I AM, I AM COMING TO DO YOUR WILL

**1 Corinthians 1:1-3** Paul greets the Church in Corinth.

**John 1:29-34** John testifies that Jesus is the Lamb of God, God's own Son.

In today's Gospel, John the Baptist sees Jesus approaching and cries out, giving witness about who Jesus is. He says that he saw the Spirit descend upon Jesus. By this sign, John the Baptist knew that Jesus was the one who is to come after him. John calls Jesus the "Lamb of God" and the "Son of God." By using these titles, John the Baptist identifies Jesus' ultimate purpose: to redeem sinful humanity. John the Baptist's mission is clearly identified: he baptized in order to prepare for and make known the ministry of the One who was to follow
