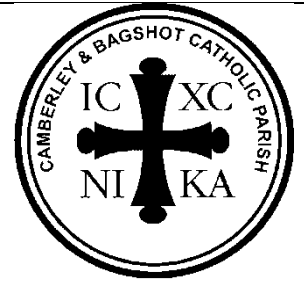

### From the Catechism

“Lay people fulfil their prophetic mission by evangelization, that is, the proclamation of Christ by word and the testimony of life. For lay people, this evangelization acquires a specific property and peculiar efficacy because it is accomplished in the ordinary circumstances of the world. This witness of life, however, is not the sole element in the apostolate, the true apostle is on the lookout for occasions of announcing Christ by word, either to unbelievers or to the faithful” (*Paragraph 905*).

“The Good News proclaimed by the witness of life sooner or later has to be proclaimed by the word of life. There is no true evangelization if the name, the teaching, the life, the promises, the kingdom and the mystery of Jesus of Nazareth, the Son of God are not proclaimed” *Blessed Paul VI*.
