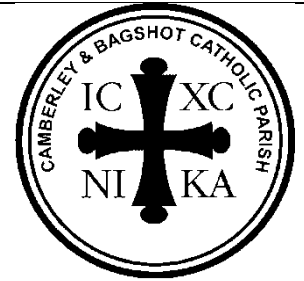

Start with a word of prayer

*Be still for a moment.....*

Thank you Lord for this time I am going to spend studying your word. (*Luke chapter 24 verses 32*)

Lord, let my heart burn within me as you open the scriptures to me and grant me understanding and union with you in Jesus name. Amen

(*John chapter 14 verses 14*)

Next - Follow the 4 steps of Lectio Divina:

1. Read
2. Meditate
3. Pray
4. Contemplate
