This Sunday we hear three parables about how to be a good disciple. The blind cannot lead the blind. And a disciple cannot be a good disciple unless he or she has learned from the teacher. Before you can be a good disciple and teach others you must take care of yourself. Do not try to take a speck out of your brother's eye until you have taken the board out of your own. Finally, only when you have purified yourself can you produce the good works that the teacher requires. Discipleship asks us to produce good deeds. But to produce them requires the integrity and purity of heart found in the teacher.

We Encounter Jesus. We grow together in His Love.

The Plans for the re-development of the St Tarcisius Church site, is the **cornerstone** for the future of the Catholic parish of Camberley and Bagshot.

It is proposed to build a new pastoral centre attached to the St Tarcisius Church in London Road, Camberley. The new building will provide modern facilities that will better support the life and mission of our parish.

Guided by our new visions statement “We encounter Jesus. We grow together in His love”, the new parish centre will be light, open, invitational and welcoming to all who engage with our parish. The facilities provided in the new building will be accessible to all, help the development of our worship, community life, support training in discipleship and enable mission and evangelisation in our local community.

Draft Plans have been drawn up for the redevelopment of the St Tarcisius site using the funds from St Tarcisius legacy and the proposed sale of the St Peter & St John site.

We want to consult with all parishioners on these plans before submitting to them the Diocese.

We will be holding two meetings followed by a survey to give every parishioner an opportunity to share their ideas and help the development team ensure we meet the parish needs for the future.

The first meeting will be held on Thursday 14th March at St Tarcisius hall with refreshments available at 7 pm. The meeting will commence at 7.30pm with an opening address by Fr Paul and Maria Dineen the project leader. This meeting is for the **Leaders** of the following groups; C&B Liturgy Committee, First Holy Communion, Confirmation, Parish Marriage Care Contact, Site Managers, Music Directors, Events Group, Alpha Hospitality Group, Youth Group, Parish Safeguarding Officer, CAFOD, Parish Counters, the Rota Organisers for the Flowers and Cleaners of all sites, Parish Redevelopment Team, Parish Mission Team, Senior Leadership Team, Parish Finance Committee.

It is envisaged that the first meeting will enable those who lead the ministries in the parish to view these plans and ensure that they meet their ministry needs.

The second meeting is for **All Parishioners** and will take place on Tuesday April 30th at St Tarcisius hall with refreshments available at 7 pm. The meeting will commence at 7.30pm with an opening address by Fr Paul and Maria Dineen the project leader. There will be a 3D presentation of the plans with commentary. All parishioners are encouraged to view the plans and give comments which are welcomed.

Following that meeting an online survey called ‘survey monkey’ will be available on the parish website for 2 weeks for people to make their comments.

At the end of the feedback period, we will share the findings with the parish via the weekend Masses and through the parish newsletter.
