'The Word who is Life' Bishop Richard is to begin a series of consultations with the lay faithful and priests of the diocese from the autumn. This will involve meeting representatives from each parish and asking them to enter into dialogue with their communities. Entitled 'The Word Who is Life' the Bishop asks us to look to the future: The Bishop writes, "...in order for us to foster prayer, develop formation and ensure continuing mission, we must review our Diocesan and Parish life. This must be carried out at a time when the ratio of priests to people is changing. This will be challenging for all concerned and difficult decisions must be made."

Married priests – a solution to the vocations crisis? Caroline Farrow, formerly of Catholic Voices, will discuss the question as to whether a cessation of the requirement of celibacy might be a solution to the current 'shortage of priests.' Caroline is married to Fr Robin Farrow, Parish Priest of Ash. **The talk will take place on Tuesday 12th September at SS Peter & John at 7.30pm (please note change of date).** All welcome.

World Day of the Poor At the conclusion of the Year of Mercy in November last year, Pope Francis in his message *Misericordia et Misera* instituted a 'World Day of the Poor' to be marked on the 33th Sunday in Ordinary Time, which this year is 19th November.
