Philomen 9-10-,12-17 "Have him back, not as a slave anymore, but as a dear brother."

Luke 14,25-33 "None of you can be my disciple unless he gives up all my possessions".

In chapter 14 of Luke's Gospel, Jesus is speaking to people gathered at the table about the difficulties of following him. Jesus speaks to them in parables, emphasizing that although there is a right way to be a disciple and enter into the kingdom of his Father, it is a difficult path to follow. Many, even some of the guests at the table, reject the invitation. Jesus explains that, when it comes to making a choice for the Kingdom of God, nothing can get in the way. choosing to be a disciple means that everything else—family, money, your own life—must come second.
