### Sunday Readings

**Isaiah 42:1-4,6-7** *Here is my servant in whom my soul delights*

**Psalm** THE LORD WILL BLESS HIS PEOPLE WITH PEACE

**Acts 10:34-38** *God anointed him with the Holy Spirit*

**Matthew 3:13-17** *As Jesus was baptised he saw the Spirit of God coming down on him*

**The Baptism of the Lord** marks a transition from the Christmas season to Ordinary Time. Before Jesus' birth, angels announced to Mary and to Joseph who Jesus would be. At his birth, the shepherds and the Magi recognize Jesus as the Messiah. At his baptism, Jesus accepts that he is God's son and inaugurates that mission. In accepting this baptism, Jesus unites himself with all sinners even though he is sinless: Christ's baptism by John prefigures the baptism that we receive. "I am baptizing you with water . . . He will baptize you with the holy Spirit and fire" (Matthew 3:11)
