The Bishops of England and Wales on the 50th Anniversary of the 1967 Abortion Act

The anniversary of the 1967 Act falls on Friday 27th October. Since then, there have been more than 8m abortions in the UK. This anniversary provides an opportunity to lament the loss of life due to abortion and seek a change of minds and hearts about the good of the child in the womb and the care of mothers who are pregnant. Every abortion is a tragedy and few consider that abortion is the desirable or best solution to a pregnancy... The complex set of conditions in which a woman finds herself pregnant and may consider having an abortion may limit the exercise of freedom and diminish moral culpability. When abortion is the choice made by a woman, the unfailing mercy of God and the promise of forgiveness through the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

(We need)..: a new understanding of the intrinsic value and worth of every human life in the womb, a better protection of unborn children diagnosed with a disability, a great need for education in moral responsibility about human sexuality and the meaning of sexual expression within marriage. We thank many people,.., who have sought to protect unborn life and the life of the mother over the last fifty years; mothers who have continued their pregnancies in difficult circumstances, politicians who have sought to reform the legislation to better protect unborn life... Together let us better cherish life.”
