
# Camberley and Bagshot Catholic Parish Newsletter Solemnity of Ss Peter & Paul Apostles 30<sup>th</sup> June 2024

**Ss Peter and Paul** are giants of the Church. Both are apostles. **St Peter** was very likely a middle-aged man when Jesus called him. He was a fisherman from Bethsaida, a village near the Lake of Galilee. Perhaps he was part of a fisherman's co-op with his brother Andrew and friends James and John. At any rate, Andrew introduced Peter to Jesus. Jesus said, "*You are Simon son of John; you are to be called Cephas, meaning Rock.*"

According to the Acts of the Apostles, Peter was the first to preach on Pentecost. He worked the first public miracle: curing the lame man at the temple gate. Peter was imprisoned three or four times. Finally, in Rome, he was sentenced to death by crucifixion. Out of respect for his Master, Jesus, he asked the guard to fasten him to the cross upside down. He was buried in an old Roman cemetery, probably where the basilica of St. Peter is today. He is called the "Prince of the Apostles." Two letters in the Bible are said to be his.

Being a devout Jew and knowledgeable in the Law, **St Paul** persecuted the Christians who were teaching strange new things. One day on the way to Damascus to hunt for Christians, Paul met Jesus. Paul became the greatest Christian missionary, preaching and founding churches. For about thirty years Paul travelled around the Roman Empire preaching about Christ and suffering. From his many letters that are in the Bible and from the Acts of the Apostles, he seems to have been affectionate, loyal, courageous, and dedicated. He was the right man to build the bridge between Jewish religion of the Old Testament and the Christianity of the New Testament. Paul was imprisoned and finally beheaded outside of the walls of Rome.
