

WE ENCOUNTER JESUS - WE GROW TOGETHER IN HIS LOVE

Making disciples who encounter the saving love of Jesus Christ Growing together by being known, loved and supported Empowered by the Holy Spirit to worship, witness, and serve

On this Sunday, we continue to read from the "Bread of Life discourse" found in the sixth chapter of John's Gospel. Today's Gospel begins with many of the crowds say they knew his family, and they knew he was the son of Joseph so they struggle to comprehend what Jesus meant when he said that he came down from heaven. Jesus responds to the complaints by saying that only those who are chosen by God will recognize him as the one that God sent. This is a recurring theme in John's Gospel, that God has chosen those who will have faith in Jesus.

In the verses that follow, Jesus speaks about his unity with the Father. He is the one who has seen the Father and, therefore, knows the Father. Those who listen to God will recognize that Jesus is the one sent from God. Those who believe, will have eternal life. Jesus concludes with the central element of our eucharistic theology. He promises that the bread of life will bring eternal life to those who partake of it, and he tells us that the bread of life will be his own flesh, given for the life of the world. Saint Teresa of Calcutta said "Jesus has made Himself the Bread of Life to give us life. Night and day, He is there. If you really want to grow in love, come back to the Eucharist, come back to that Adoration." To grow in love for Jesus requires spending time in the real presence in the eucharist at adoration or before the tabernacle.

"I adore you Jesus, true God, and true man, present in the Holy Eucharist. In gratitude for so great a blessing, I love you with all my heart, for you are worthy of all praise and adoration. Lord Jesus Christ, may I never offend you with my lack of love. May your Eucharistic presence refresh me in body and soul. Mary, Mother of the Eucharistic Lord, pray for me and obtain for me a greater love for Jesus. Amen."
