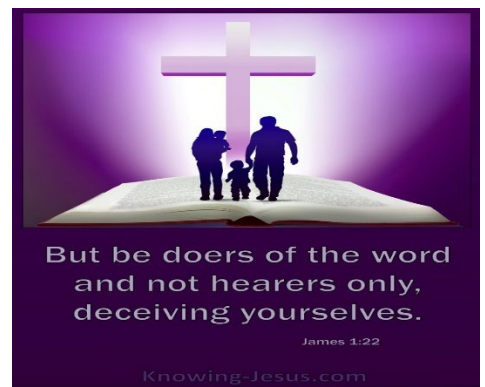

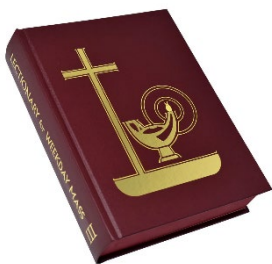

A new edition of the **Lectionary**, the book which contains the readings which are proclaimed at Mass, will come into use in England and Wales in **Advent 2024**. This is part of the wider liturgical vision which began with the revised order of mass in 2011. The new edition uses the “*English Standard Version - Catholic Edition*” for the readings and the “*Abbey Psalms and Canticles*” for the Responsorial Psalms. The new Lectionary will be in four volumes: one for Sundays and Solemnities, two volumes for

Weekdays and the Proper of Saints, and a final volume with Ritual Masses, Masses for the Dead, Weddings, Baptisms etc

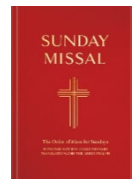
The parish has ordered three sets of the four volumes lectionaries, a copy of the Book of the Gospels to be used by Deacon Simon, and new copies to the Parish Mass Books which will also be used from the beginning of Advent. The total cost of spending on the new lectionaries and parish Mass book will come to **£8000** and to defray these costs we are taking a **retiring collection** at Masses this weekend.



You can access the scriptures used at mass by downloading the “*Universalis App*” (£10) on Goggle Play. The app will give you comprehensive access to our Catholic liturgy.

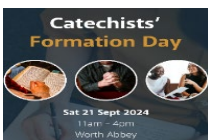
