St Tarcisius Centenary is taking part in the **Heritage Open Days** 7th – 15th September 2024. <u>www.heritageopendays.org.uk</u>. The Heritage Website says "Heritage Open Days is England's largest festival of history and culture, involving thousands of local volunteers and organisations. Every year for 10 days in September it brings people together to celebrate their heritage, community and history"

We have included St Tarcisius Church as it is the centenary of it's opening. **St Tarcisius Church** was built between 1923 and 1924. The church was designed by Frederick Walters as a War Memorial for fallen British Catholic military officers in the First World War. It served as the chaplaincy for Catholics at the Royal Military Academy Sandhurst. The War Memorial Plaque features the names of some 150 officers and men who were at some time or other members of the congregation and who were killed in the Great War of 1914-18.

In 1879 Charlotte Mary, Viscountess Southwell who lived at France Hill House gave the London Road site for a permanent church and in 1888 'The Priest's House' was built on the London Road site and later on, the Iron church was moved alongside it. In 1906, Fr Patrick Twomey came to Camberley

and on the 1st July 1908 started a fund to build a new permanent church. The total cost of building St Tarcisius Church was £12,500 and the money was raised in its entirety by the efforts of Canon Patrick Twomey, donors and local Catholics with the help of the Military Academy. Building commenced 1st July 1923, and the foundation stone being laid on the 12th September by the Bishop of Southwark. On 18 November 1924, the church was opened and on the 26 June 1926 the new Church and High Altars were consecrated by Bishop W F Brown, auxiliary bishop of Southwark.

<u>If coming along the A30 from Bagshot direction</u>, turn left onto Knoll Road, then at the end of the road at the T Junction turn Right onto Portesbury Road, then continue straight over the mini round about onto Pembroke Broadway, follow the road around to the right at Lower Charles Street. This will bring you to the rear of the Atrium and St Tarcisius carpark is on the left at the next mini roundabout.

<u>If coming along the A30 from Blackwater</u>, you can use the turning for the York Town Industrial estate. On the A331 (Blackwater Velley Relief Road) at the first set of lights turn Left onto Stanhope Road, continue straight over the mini roundabout, then at the bend turn right passing through the barrier at the top of Queen Mary Avenue, Continue Straight over the cross roads to Edward Avenue and at the T Junction, turn right onto Frimley Road. Continue along Frimley Road until you reach Halfords Car garage on the left, then take the next left onto The Avenue. Continue along The Avenue and take the 4<sup>th</sup> right onto Southwell Park Road, at the next T Junction, take a left onto Lower Charles street. Continue a short distance to the mini roundabout and turn left into St Tarcisius hall car park.
