

Friday 1st November; the Solemnity of All Saints. Every year the Church recalls the example, witness, and prayer of the holy women and men who have been identified by the Church as Saints. From the first centuries after Christ, Christians who died a martyr's death were considered saints, who live in God's presence forever. Every year, on the anniversary of the martyrs' deaths, Christians would visit

their tombs and celebrate the Eucharist. This practice grew throughout the centuries to include remembering other outstanding Christians on the days they died. Soon the entire calendar was filled with memorials of the saints. In the ninth century, Pope Gregory IV designated November 1 as the day to remember all the saints living in God's presence. The saints are more than just role models; they are family members with whom we continue to share relation, in a bond of prayer, called the Communion of Saints.

Saturday 2nd November; All Souls Day (Commemoration of the Faithful Departed) When we pray for the souls of the faithful departed, we are praying for those whose souls are journeying through purgatory, being prepared for eternal life in heaven. We believe that our prayers for them will help to speed their journey to eternal life with God in heaven.



The Church designates November as the month of the holy Souls, to pray for and remember those who have died. The month of November gives each of us the opportunity to remember our dearly departed family and friends. We enter their names on the list of the dead and place their names in front of the Altars to remember them during this month. The lists to write the names of your beloved deceased are found at the back of our churches



To mark the 100th Anniversary of St Tarcisius the Remembrance parade in Camberley on Sunday 10th November. At approx 3pm, the parade will briefly stop outside St Tarcisius church as a mark of respect to the fallen, on its route from St Michaels Church along the London Road (A30) to the War Memorial outside the Royal Military Academy Sandhurst.
