Preparing your child for First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion

The preparation for their First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion is a very important time for your children. Parents are the main teachers of the faith to their children, and you will be supported by the parish catechists in using a programme called, 'Growing up Catholic.' The programme is open to children in Year 3 and above. At the end of the course your child will make his or her first Holy Communion in the church at which you worship and complete this course.

Before registering your child/children for this course, please note that there is a time commitment involved and it is an essential part of the course that you and your child/children are present at every session. The preparation for First Holy Communion and Reconciliation begins in December and a timetable of dates & times is provided.

As parents are very important to the preparation course there will be a short course for parents before we start preparation for First Holy Communion. These parents only sessions are very important, so I do require you to attend them.

- This course consists of two sessions and will take place over zoom. You will need access to a computer, if you do not have access to a computer, please let me know. The two sessions will take place on Thursday 9th November ("who is Jesus") and Thursday 16th November (The Eucharist) starting at 7.30pm A zoom link will be sent to you by email before the evenings.
- There will also be a meeting at St Tarcisius Church Hall on Thursday 23rd November from 7.30pm when the catechists will take you through the process of preparation for First Confessions and First Communion.

The parish will need to receive a completed application form by **October 31st 2023.** Please attach a photocopy of your child's baptism certificate and your donation of £25 per child for the materials for this programme.

Please bring your application forms along to one of our Sunday masses to hand to me as it will be a good opportunity to meet and chat about your child/children's preparation.
